

HIGHLIGHT : 2017-18

- Programme expenditure of ₹ 7549.22 crore done which is 90.76% of the total budget outlay of ₹ 8318.22 Crores.
- Additional irrigation potential of 2.15 lakh hectares have been created and stabilisation of Irrigation potential of 0.59 lakh hectares done.
- 15 Minor Irrigation Projects have been completed.
- ₹ 592.39 crore water tax have been collected from Industrial and Commercial establishments.
- OIIPCRA (Odisha Integrated Irrigation Project for Climate Resilient Agriculture) to be implemented with the support of World Bank.
- 1287 community Lift Irrigation Project (LIPs) installed with an irrigation potential of 28442 hectares.
- 13011 Deep Borewells energised and handed over to beneficiaries.
- 1185 nos. of defunct LIPs having CCA of 25,236 hectares have been revived.
- Construction of 2663 Check Dams have been completed.
- Rehabilitation of 4 Dams namely Kalo, Nesa, Dhanei, Sundar have been completed.
- Field channels work covering 65804 hectares and field drain work covering 12906 hectares completed under CAD&WM.
